

MISSIONS EXPO ROUND-UP



We have had a FANTASTIC and productive week at FUMC, hosting the Missions Expo 2020 event for Experience Missions. In speaking with Paul Kinley, Founder and Project Manager at Experience Missions, he relayed the following statistics from the week:

-Approximately 250 volunteers, ranging in age from 1 year old to 94 years old, came from as far away as Downingtown, PA to participate in the event.

-100,000 nutritious meals were packed for Kids Around the World to be distributed in Haiti.

-1,000 international school kits were assembled for Christian Aid Ministries.

-225 Action Packs were packed by our youth group and guests to offer vital supplies for Syrian refugees.

-Nearly 10 tons of Christian literature were collected and sorted. This will provide vital supplies for ministers spreading the Gospel overseas.

-Approximately 24,000 green squash and 24,000 collard green seeds were packaged to be distributed to pastors around the world.

-Approximately 3,500 Bibles were collected and will be distributed around the world.

Kinley is quoted saying, “First United Methodist Church’s hospitality, accommodations and personnel have been a joy to work with. We look forward to future ways to partner together for the glory of God.”
